IN RE: SB999 by Eltife (Relating to possession of or access to a child in a suit affecting the parent-child relationship during or after military deployment of the child's parent.), **Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend statute by expanding provisions that apply to the possession of or access to a child during or after a conservator's military deployment.
