IN RE: SB999 by Eltife (Relating to possession of or access to a child in a suit affecting the parent-child relationship during military deployment or mobilization of the child's parent.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend statute by expanding provisions that apply to the possession of or access to a child when a conservator is deployed or mobilized by the military.
