IN RE: SB1053 by Zaffirini (Relating to assessing the quality and effectiveness of academic advising services offered by public institutions of higher education.), **As Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require the Higher Education Coordinating Board to establish a method for assessing the quality and effectiveness of academic advising services available to students at each institution of higher education. The Higher Education Coordinating Board would be able to implement provisions of the bill within existing resources.
