The bill amends the Government Code to allow for money in the disaster contingency fund to be used to provide assistance to producers of agricultural products affected by a disaster caused by severe drought or wildfire. According to the Comptroller's Cash Report for fiscal year 2006, the current balance in the Disaster Contingency Fund No. 453 is \$107,160.
