IN RE: SB1392 by Uresti (Relating to the rights of certain incapacitated persons that may be terminated by a court in a guardianship proceeding.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require an application for the appointment of guardianship to include a request of rights to be terminated, including termination of the right of a proposed ward 18 years of age or older to cast a vote in a public election and termination of the proposed ward's right to operate a motor vehicle.
