IN RE: SB1411 by West, Royce (Relating to requirements for judicial training on issues regarding family violence, sexual assault, and child abuse and neglect.), **Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Government Code relating to requirements for judicial training on issues regarding family violence, sexual assault, and child abuse and neglect. The bill would direct training to include additional information on such issues as described. To the extent the bill would make new requirements for judicial training, no significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2007.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
