**IN RE: SB1417** by Hinojosa (Relating to the student endowment scholarship and internship program fund at Texas A&M University--Corpus Christi.), **As Engrossed**

<b>No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.</b>

Under provisions of the bill, the Texas A&M University System Board of Regents is authorized to impose a student endowment fund fee on each student enrolled at Texas A&M University - Corpus Christi. The amount of revenue generated by the fee, locally assessed by Texas A&M University - Corpus Christi, would depend on the fee amount assessed by the University and could increase with enrollment growth.

**Local Government Impact**
