**IN RE: SB1584** by Gallegos (Relating to the deduction from a deputy sheriff's wages or salary in certain counties for payment of membership dues to an employee association.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would apply to the sheriff in a county with a population of one million or more that adopted Chapter 174, Local Government Code, after January 1, 2004. The bracket would apply to Bexar County only.

**Local Government Impact**

Because the bill would not have statewide impact on units of local government of the same type or class, no comment from this office is required by the rules of the House/Senate as to its probable fiscal implication on units of local government.
