**IN RE: SB1589** by Shapleigh (Relating to municipal and county authority to enforce a solid waste collection and transportation services franchise; providing a penalty.), **As Engrossed**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Health and Safety Code to specify that a violation of a rule adopted under Section 364.011 would be a Class C misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed \$200, and that each day of a continuing violation would constitute a separate offense.
