IN RE: SB1589 by Shapleigh (Relating to municipal and county authority to enforce a solid waste collection and transportation services franchise; providing penalty.), Committee Report 1st House, Substituted

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Health and Safety Code to specify that a violation of a rule adopted under Section 364.011 would be a Class C misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed \$200, and that each day of a continuing violation would constitute a separate offense.
