**IN RE: SB1667** by Averitt (Relating to the amount of an administrative penalty assessed by the Railroad Commission of Texas for a violation of the Texas Surface Coal Mining and Reclamation Act or a permit issued under that act.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would raise the maximum administrative penalty for each violation issued under the coal mining regulatory program administered by the Railroad Commission from \$5,000 to \$10,000.

The Railroad Commission estimates that the bill would result in a gain to the General Revenue Fund of \$24,792 per fiscal year.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
