IN RE: SB1690 by Watson (Relating to the authority of a county to zone, apply building standards, and impose impact fees in an area near certain toll projects; providing a penalty.), As Introduced

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

Based on the eligibility criteria stipulated in the bill, the provisions would apply only to the counties of Travis, Williamson, and Caldwell.
