**IN RE: SB1729** by Carona (Relating to the inspection, installation, maintenance, and repair of elevators, escalators, chairlifts, people movers, moving sidewalks, platform lifts, and related equipment.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted** 

#### No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Health and Safety Code to require the 2005 version of the American Society of Mechanical Engineers Safety Code for Elevators and Escalators to be adhered to for new construction and installation of equipment.

Based on information provided by the Department of Licensing and Regulation, it is assumed that any additional costs related to the duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be covered by utilizing existing resources.

The bill would take effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all members elected to each house; otherwise the bill would take effect immediately.

### **Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
