# FISCAL NOTE, 80TH LEGISLATIVE REGULAR SESSION

**IN RE: SB1776** by Duncan (Relating to the requirements for accessibility to voting equipment by persons with disabilities in certain elections.), **As Introduced** 

### No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Election Code to remove the January 1, 2006 deadline reference for polling places to provide at least one voting station to accommodate persons with disabilities. The bill would add to the accommodations for which at least one station must comply, accessibility under 42 U.S.C. Section 15481(a)(3) and its subsequent amendments.

Section 61.013 would be added to the Election Code to provide an exception to providing at least one voting station that complies with various listed federal laws regarding accomodations for persons with disabilities. The exception would apply to a political subdivision, other than a county and other than for a jointly held election in which a federal office appears on the ballot, and would be applied based on population criteria or on proof the accomodation would create an undue burden. The political subdivision would be required to file an application with the Secretary of State not later than 90 days before the election to seek the exception. The Secretary of State would be required to make a determination within 20 days after receipt of the application.

The bill would repeal the stipulation that the only polling places required to accomodate voters with disabilities would be those that use an electronic voting system.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2007.

Based on analysis from the Secretary of State, requirements under the bill could be achieved utilizing existing resources.

## **Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
