**IN RE: SJR48** by Ogden (Proposing a constitutional amendment to limit the time during which a person who holds an appointive position that is subject to senate confirmation on a multimember state board or commission continues to perform the duties of the office after the expiration of the person's term of office.), **As Introduced** 

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated, other than the cost of publication.

The cost to the state for publication of the resolution is \$77,468.

The resolution would prohibit a person who holds an appointive position whose term expires during a regular session of the legislature and whose position is subject to Senate confirmation from serving past the end of the session. Likewise, if the person's term expires during a recess of the Senate, the person cannot serve past the end of the next regular session.

## **Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
