IN RE: SJR49 by Jackson, Mike (Proposing a constitutional amendment limiting the service of certain officeholders after the expiration of the person's term of office.), **As Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated, other than the cost of publication.

The cost to the state for publication of the resolution is \$77,468.

The resolution would prohibit an officer appointed by the Governor and subject to the advice and consent of the Senate from serving past the expiration of their term if the Senate, during a regular or special session, votes by two-thirds to adopt a resolution declaring an end to the officer's service.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
