**IN RE: SJR60** by Duncan (Proposing a constitutional amendment providing for the continuation of the constitutional appropriation for facilities and other capital items at Angelo State University on a change in the governance of the university.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated,** other than the cost of publication.

The cost to the state for publication of the resolution is \$77,468.

The bill would require a referendum of the voters of Texas on a constitutional amendment to move the Higher Education Fund appropriation for Angelo State University from the Texas State University System to a newly created Texas Tech University System listing.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
