No. 589 (senate committee printing) by adding the 1 following appropriately numbered SECTIONS to the bill and 2 renumbering the subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly: 3 SECTION \_\_\_\_\_. Subsection (d), Section 87.841, Education 4 Code, is amended to read as follows: 5 (d) Notwithstanding any other provision of this subchapter, 6 Texas A&M University--San Antonio may not operate as a general 7 academic teaching institution until the Texas Higher Education 8 Coordinating Board certifies that enrollment at the Texas A&M 9 University--Kingsville System Center--San Antonio has reached an 10 enrollment equivalent of 1,000 full-time students for one semester 11 or one academic year. In computing the full-time student 12 enrollment equivalent for an academic year under this subsection, 13 the coordinating board shall include all semester credit hours 14 completed during the fall and spring semesters and the summer 15 session of the academic year [+ 16 (1) 1,000 full-time students for one semester if the 17 legislature authorizes revenue bonds to be issued to finance 18 educational and related facilities for the institution, and the 19 20 bonds are issued for that purpose; or [(2) 2,500 full-time students for one semester if the 21 conditions specified by Subdivision (1) are not satisfied]. 22 SECTION \_\_\_\_. (d) Notwithstanding any other provision of this subchapter, the University of North Texas at Dallas may operate as a general academic teaching institution with its own chief executive officer, administration, and faculty only after the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board certifies that enrollment at the University of

North Texas System Center at Dallas has reached an enrollment 1 equivalent to 1,000 full-time students for one semester or one 2 In computing the full-time student enrollment 3 academic year. equivalent for an academic year under this subsection, the 4 coordinating board shall include all semester credit hours 5 completed during the fall and spring semesters and the summer 6 session of the academic year. Until that enrollment level is 7 reached, the board may operate a system center of the University of 8 North Texas in the city of Dallas. [Prior to reaching 2,500 9 full-time equivalent students, the University of North Texas at 10 Dallas may not receive general revenue in excess of the 2003 11 expended amount with the exception of funding provided through the 12 General Academic Instruction and Operations Formula for semester 13 credit hour increases and the Tuition Revenue Bond debt service for 14 bonds approved in the 78th Legislature. The institution will not be 1.5 eligible to receive the small school supplement in the General 16 Academic Instruction and Operations Formula until it reaches 2,500 17 full-time equivalent student enrollment. 18
