- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 466.355(b), Government Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b) Money in the state lottery account may be used only for 8 the following purposes and shall be distributed as follows:
- 9 (1) the payment of prizes to the holders of winning 10 tickets;
- 11 (2) the payment of costs incurred in the operation and 12 administration of the <u>commission</u> [lottery], including any fees paid
- 13 to [received by] a lottery operator, provided that the costs
- 14 incurred in a fiscal biennium may not exceed an amount equal to 12
- 15 percent of the gross revenue accruing from the sale of tickets in
- 16 that biennium;

- 17 (3) the establishment of a pooled bond fund, lottery
- 18 prize reserve fund, unclaimed prize fund, and prize payment
- 19 account; and
- 20 (4) the balance, after creation of a reserve
- 21 sufficient to pay the amounts needed or estimated to be needed under
- 22 Subdivisions (1) through (3), to be transferred to the foundation
- 23 school fund, on or before the 15th day of each month.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
