16	bus before departure, provided that the engine is turned off when a
17	student is embarking or disembarking.
18	SECTION 2. Section 34.0041, Education Code, as added by
19	this Act, applies beginning with the 2007-2008 school year.
20	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
21	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
22	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
23	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
24	Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
