A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT 1 relating to the county courts at law in Nueces County. 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 3 SECTION 1. Section 25.1802(e), Government Code, is amended 4 to read as follows: 5 (e) The judges [judge] of the county courts at law in Nueces 6 County [Court at Law No. 1, 2, or 3 of Nueces County may be paid, and 7 the judge of County Court at Law No. 4 and the judge of County Court 8 at Law No. 5 of Nueces County] shall each be paid[τ] an annual 9 salary equal to the amount that is \$1,000 less than the salary paid 10 by the state to a district judge in the county. The salaries shall 11 be paid in the same manner and from the same fund as prescribed by 12 law for the county judge. 13 SECTION 2. Sections 25.1802(f) and (g), Government Code, 14 are repealed. 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
