1 WHEREAS, After nearly three decades of outstanding service,
2 Patricia Mouser retired from her position as child nutrition
3 services director for the Midland Independent School District in
4 June 2009; and

5 WHEREAS, Mrs. Mouser earned a degree in nutrition from Texas
6 Tech University, where she was a student supervisor in food service
7 and later a campus dietician; she also worked for the San Antonio
8 Independent School District for four years before returning to her
9 hometown and joining Midland ISD; and

10 WHEREAS, As the director of child nutrition services, Mrs.
11 Mouser oversaw the delivery of meals to more than 20,000 students in
12 the district, and throughout her tenure, she sought to develop an
13 awareness of healthy eating habits among the children and to
14 improve on the food program by incorporating the latest
15 developments in nutrition and technology; under Mrs. Mouser's
16 skilled leadership, the department has adapted its menus
17 considerably, and it has greatly expanded its breakfast program;

19 WHEREAS, Mrs. Mouser is planning to relocate to Round Rock to
20 be closer to her family; in addition, she will continue her work as
21 a consultant and trainer for the National Food Service Management
22 Institute; and

23 WHEREAS, With the utmost dedication and professionalism,
24 Patricia Mouser has made significant contributions to the health

1 and well-being of the Midland ISD students, and she may indeed
2 reflect with great pride on her notable accomplishments as she
3 embarks on the next exciting chapter of her life; now, therefore, be
