7 and after selling out his first solo show in 1974, he began pursuing  
8 art full-time; and

10 the cover of more than three dozen magazines, including *Western*  
11 *Horseman*, *The Quarter Horse Journal*, *The Cattleman*, *Beef*, and  
12 *Today's Horse*, and he is one of the best-selling artists for Leanin'  
13 Tree Christmas and Greeting Cards; moreover, he is the author and  
14 illustrator of two books, *Everything I Know I Learned from My*  
15 *Grandpa: Silver-Haired Wisdom for the Young at Heart* and *Growing Up*  
16 *Cowboy*; and

17           WHEREAS, Wholly dedicated to his art, Jack Sorenson has  
18 touched the lives of individuals across Texas and beyond with his  
19 vivid and detailed renderings of cowboy life, and the Lone Star  
20 State is indeed proud to call him a native son; now, therefore, be
