AN ACT

2 relating to the governmental entities subject to the sunset review
3 process.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

ARTICLE 1. ENTITIES GIVEN 2011 SUNSET DATE

6 SECTION 1.01. STATE SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION BOARD. 7 Section 201.025, Agriculture Code, is amended to read as follows:

8 Sec. 201.025. SUNSET PROVISION. The State Soil and Water 9 Conservation Board is subject to Chapter 325, Government Code 10 (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by 11 that chapter, the board is abolished and this chapter expires 12 September 1, 2011 [2013].

SECTION 1.02. TEXAS FOREST SERVICE. Subchapter B, Chapter 88, Education Code, is amended by adding Section 88.1016 to read as follows:

Sec. 88.1016. SUNSET PROVISION. The Texas Forest Service
 is subject to Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act).
 Unless continued in existence as provided by that chapter, the
 Texas Forest Service is abolished September 1, 2011.

20 SECTION 1.03. EQUINE RESEARCH ACCOUNT ADVISORY COMMITTEE. 21 Subsection (b), Section 88.524, Education Code, is amended to read 22 as follows:

(b) The Equine Research Account Advisory Committee is
subject to Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless

1 continued in existence as provided by that chapter, the advisory
2 committee is abolished and this subchapter expires September 1,
3 2011 [2009].

SECTION 1.04. TEXAS STATE AFFORDABLE HOUSING CORPORATION.
Section 2306.5521, Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

6 Sec. 2306.5521. SUNSET PROVISION. The Texas State 7 Affordable Housing Corporation is subject to Chapter 325 (Texas 8 Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by that 9 chapter, the corporation is abolished and this subchapter expires 10 September 1, 2011 [2009].

11 SECTION 1.05. ON-SITE WASTEWATER TREATMENT RESEARCH 12 COUNCIL. Section 367.003, Health and Safety Code, is amended to 13 read as follows:

Sec. 367.003. APPLICATION OF SUNSET ACT. (a) The council is subject to Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by that chapter, the council is abolished and this chapter expires September 1, <u>2011</u> [<u>2013</u>].

(b) If this chapter expires under Subsection (a), 20 uncommitted money in the on-site wastewater treatment research 21 account shall be deposited to the credit of the general revenue 22 fund.

SECTION 1.06. TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF INSURANCE. Subsection (a), Section 31.004, Insurance Code, is amended to read as follows: (a) The Texas Department of Insurance is subject to Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by that chapter, the department is abolished

1 September 1, <u>2011</u> [2009].

2 SECTION 1.07. OFFICE OF PUBLIC INSURANCE COUNSEL. Section
3 501.003, Insurance Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 501.003. SUNSET PROVISION. The office is subject to Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by that chapter, the office is abolished September 1, <u>2011</u> [2009].

8 SECTION 1.08. COASTAL COORDINATION COUNCIL. Section 9 33.211, Natural Resources Code, is amended to read as follows:

10 Sec. 33.211. SUNSET PROVISION. The Coastal Coordination 11 Council is subject to Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset 12 Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by that chapter, 13 the council is abolished and this subchapter expires September 1, 14 <u>2011</u> [2013].

15 SECTION 1.09. STATE BOARD OF EXAMINERS FOR SPEECH-LANGUAGE 16 PATHOLOGY AND AUDIOLOGY. Section 401.002, Occupations Code, is 17 amended to read as follows:

Sec. 401.002. APPLICATION OF SUNSET ACT. The State Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology is subject to Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by that chapter, the board is abolished and this chapter expires September 1, <u>2011</u> [2013].

SECTION 1.10. STATE COMMITTEE OF EXAMINERS IN THE FITTING
 AND DISPENSING OF HEARING INSTRUMENTS. Section 402.002,
 Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows:

26 Sec. 402.002. APPLICATION OF SUNSET ACT. The State 27 Committee of Examiners in the Fitting and Dispensing of Hearing

Instruments is subject to Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas
 Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by that
 chapter, the committee is abolished and this chapter expires
 September 1, 2011 [2013].

The board shall be reviewed during the period in which state agencies abolished in <u>2011</u> [2013] and every 12th year after <u>2011</u> [2013] are reviewed.

26 SECTION 1.14. RAILROAD COMMISSION OF TEXAS. (a) Article 27 6445a, Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:

Art. 6445a. SUNSET PROVISION. The Railroad Commission of Texas is subject to Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by that chapter, the commission is abolished September 1, <u>2011</u> [2013].

5 (b) Section 81.01001, Natural Resources Code, as added by 6 S.B. No. 1540, Acts of the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, 7 and as effective April 1, 2011, is amended to read as follows:

8 Sec. 81.01001. SUNSET PROVISION. The Railroad Commission 9 of Texas is subject to Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset 10 Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by that chapter, 11 the commission is abolished September 1, <u>2011</u> [2013].

21 SECTION 2.01. TEXAS EDUCATION AGENCY. Section 7.004, 22 Education Code, is amended to read as follows:

23 Sec. 7.004. SUNSET PROVISION. The Texas Education Agency 24 is subject to Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). 25 Unless continued in existence as provided by that chapter, the 26 agency is abolished September 1, <u>2013</u> [2012]. [In the review of the 27 agency by the Sunset Advisory Commission, as required by this

1 section, the sunset commission shall limit its review to the 2 appropriateness of recommendations made by the sunset commission to 3 the 79th Legislature. In the Sunset Advisory Commission's report 4 to the 80th Legislature, the sunset commission may include any 5 recommendations it considers appropriate.]

Sec. 531.004. SUNSET PROVISION. The Health and Human
Services Commission is subject to Chapter 325 (Texas Sunset Act).
Unless continued in existence as provided by that chapter, the
commission is abolished and this chapter expires September 1, 2013
[2011].

9 SECTION 2.06. TAX DIVISION, STATE OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE 10 HEARINGS. Subsection (b), Section 2003.102, Government Code, is 11 amended to read as follows:

(b) The Sunset Advisory Commission shall evaluate the tax division and present to the <u>83rd</u> [82nd] Legislature a report on that evaluation and the commission's recommendations in relation to the tax division.

16 SECTION 2.07. TRANSFER OF PURCHASING POWERS ТО THE 17 COMPTROLLER OF PUBLIC ACCOUNTS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS.  SERVICES. Section 117.003, Human Resources Code, is amended to

Sec. 117.003. SUNSET PROVISION. The Department of
Assistive and Rehabilitative Services is subject to Chapter 325,
Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence
as provided by that chapter, the department is abolished and this
chapter expires September 1, 2013 [2011].

9 SECTION 2.14. TEXAS COUNCIL ON PURCHASING FROM PEOPLE WITH 10 DISABILITIES. Section 122.006, Human Resources Code, is amended to 11 read as follows:

Sec. 122.006. SUNSET PROVISION. The Texas Council on Purchasing from People with Disabilities is subject to Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by that chapter, the council is abolished and this chapter expires September 1, <u>2013</u> [2015].

SECTION 2.15. DEPARTMENT OF AGING AND DISABILITY SERVICES.
Section 161.003, Human Resources Code, is amended to read as
follows:

Sec. 161.003. SUNSET PROVISION. The Department of Aging and Disability Services is subject to Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by that chapter, the department is abolished and this chapter expires September 1, <u>2013</u> [2011].

25 SECTION 2.16. OFFICE OF FIREFIGHTERS' PENSION 26 COMMISSIONER. Subsection (h), Section 21, Article 6243e, Texas 27 Local Fire Fighters Retirement Act (Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes),

1 is amended to read as follows:

(h) The office of fire fighters' pension commissioner is
subject to Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless
continued in existence as provided by that chapter, the office is
abolished September 1, 2013 [2011].

ARTICLE 3. SUNSET ADVISORY COMMISSION

SECTION 3.01. REVIEW OF AGENCIES REVIEWED FOR THE 81ST 7 LEGISLATURE. For a state agency that was reviewed by the Sunset 8 9 Advisory Commission in preparation for the work of the 81st 10 Legislature in Regular Session and the abolition date of which was extended to 2011, the commission, unless expressly provided 11 otherwise, shall limit its review of the agency in preparation for 12 13 the work of the 82nd Legislature in Regular Session to the appropriateness of recommendations made by the commission to the 14 15 81st Legislature. In the commission's report to the 82nd Legislature, the commission may include any recommendations it 16 considers appropriate. This section expires September 1, 2011. 17

SECTION 3.02. REVIEW OF THE ELECTRIC RELIABILITY COUNCIL OF 18 TEXAS. The Sunset Advisory Commission shall 19 conduct а special-purpose review of the Electric Reliability Council of Texas 20 as part of the commission's review of the Public Utility Commission 21 22 of Texas for the 82nd Legislature. The sunset commission's report to the 82nd Legislature regarding the review must include an 23 assessment of the governance, management, and operating structure 24 25 of the council and the council's compliance with the duties and requirements placed on it by the legislature and the Public Utility 26 27 Commission of Texas. The sunset commission's report under this

section may include any recommendations it considers appropriate. 1 2 The council shall pay the cost incurred by the Sunset Advisory Commission in performing the special-purpose review of the council 3 4 under this section. The Sunset Advisory Commission shall determine the cost of the review and submit a statement detailing the cost of 5 the review to the council. The council shall promptly pay the cost 6 7 of the review on receipt of the statement. This section expires September 1, 2011. 8

SECTION 3.03. PAYMENT FOR REVIEW OF CERTAIN ENTITIES FOR 9 10 THE 82ND LEGISLATURE. Rider No. 7, Article X, S.B. No. 1, Acts of 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009 (the General 11 the Appropriations Act, appropriations 12 to the House of 13 Representatives, page X-3), is amended by adding Subsection c to 14 read as follows:

15 <u>c. The money that an entity is required by law to pay to the</u> 16 <u>Sunset Advisory Commission to cover the costs the commission incurs</u> 17 <u>in performing a review of the entity is appropriated to the</u> 18 <u>commission for maintaining the operations of the commission. Money</u> 19 <u>appropriated to the commission under this subsection is in addition</u> 20 <u>to the aggregate amounts appropriated to the commission under</u> 21 Subsection a.

ARTICLE 4. EFFECTIVE DATE

23 SECTION 4.01. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect 24 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members 25 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas 26 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for 27 immediate effect, this Act takes effect on the 91st day after the

1 last day of the legislative session.
