	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1	AN ACT
2	relating to the eligibility of certain employees, postdoctoral
3	fellows, and graduate students to participate in health benefit
4	programs at public institutions of higher education.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 1551, Insurance Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 1551.1022 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 1551.1022. PARTICIPATION ELIGIBILITY: CERTAIN
9	POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWS AND GRADUATE STUDENTS. (a) An individual is
10	eligible to participate in the group benefits program if the
11	individual, at an institution of higher education:
12	(1) holds a postdoctoral fellowship; or
13	(2) holds other graduate fellowships awarded to the
14	individual on a competitive basis that, either singly or in
15	combination, are valued at not less than \$10,000.
16	(b) An institution of higher education at which an

- 17 individual holds a fellowship described by Subsection (a) is responsible for payment of the contributions for the individual. 18 19 Each participant shall contribute that portion of the cost of the 20 group coverage selected by the individual that exceeds the amount of contribution funded by the institution. All portions of the 21
- contribution funded by the institution shall be made in proportion 22
- to the source of funds from which the fellowship is paid, to the 23
- 24 extent allowed by the terms of the fellowship.

- 1 (c) An institution of higher education shall, at the time of
- 2 initial eligibility, notify each of the individuals eligible to
- 3 participate in the group benefits program under Subsection (a) of
- 4 the individual's eligibility to participate in the program.
- 5 SECTION 2. Subchapter G, Chapter 1551, Insurance Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 1551.3111 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1551.3111. AMOUNT OF STATE CONTRIBUTION FOR CERTAIN
- 8 JUNIOR COLLEGE EMPLOYEES. (a) In determining the amount to be
- 9 <u>certified under Section 1551.311</u>, the board of trustees shall
- 10 include eligible public junior college employees.
- 11 (b) For purposes of this section, a public junior college
- 12 employee is eligible if the employee is:
- (1) otherwise eligible to participate in the group
- 14 benefits program; and
- 15 (2) an instructional or administrative employee whose
- 16 salary may be fully paid from funds appropriated under the General
- 17 Appropriations Act, regardless of whether the salary is actually
- 18 paid from appropriated funds.
- 19 (c) In determining the amount described in Subsection (a),
- 20 the number of eligible employees included for each college in each
- 21 biennium shall be adjusted in proportion to the change in student
- 22 enrollment at each college during the reporting period, except that
- 23 a college that experiences a decline in student enrollment may
- 24 petition to maintain the number of eligible employees at the same
- 25 level as the prior biennium.
- SECTION 3. Subchapter C, Chapter 1601, Insurance Code, is
- 27 amended by adding Section 1601.1021 to read as follows:

- 1 Sec. 1601.1021. PARTICIPATION ELIGIBILITY: CERTAIN
- 2 POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWS AND GRADUATE STUDENTS. (a) An individual is
- 3 eligible to participate in the uniform program if the individual,
- 4 at an institution in a system:
- 5 (1) holds a postdoctoral fellowship; or
- 6 (2) holds other graduate fellowships awarded to the
- 7 individual on a competitive basis that, either singly or in
- 8 combination, are valued at not less than \$10,000.
- 9 (b) An institution of higher education at which an
- 10 individual holds a fellowship described by Subsection (a) is
- 11 responsible for payment of the contributions for the individual.
- 12 Each participant shall contribute that portion of the cost of the
- 13 group coverage selected by the individual that exceeds the amount
- 14 of contribution funded by the institution. All portions of the
- 15 contribution funded by the institution shall be made in proportion
- 16 to the source of funds from which the fellowship is paid, to the
- 17 extent allowed by the terms of the fellowship.
- 18 (c) An institution of higher education shall, at the time of
- 19 initial eligibility, notify each of the individuals eligible to
- 20 participate in the group benefits program under Subsection (a) of
- 21 the individual's eligibility to participate in the program.
- 22 SECTION 4. Effective January 1, 2010, Section 1601.101(d),
- 23 Insurance Code, is repealed.
- SECTION 5. (a) The board of trustees of the Employees
- 25 Retirement System of Texas shall include coverage under Section
- 26 1551.1022, Insurance Code, as added by this Act, in an insurance
- 27 policy or contract or evidence of coverage delivered, issued for

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- 1 delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2010. The board of
- 2 trustees may include coverage under Section 1551.1022, Insurance
- 3 Code, as added by this Act, in an insurance policy or contract or an
- 4 evidence of coverage delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed
- 5 before January 1, 2010, if the board of trustees determines that the
- 6 coverage may reasonably be included.
- 7 (b) The governing board of The University of Texas System or
- 8 The Texas A&M University System, as applicable, shall include
- 9 coverage under Section 1601.1021, Insurance Code, as added by this
- 10 Act, in an insurance policy or contract or evidence of coverage
- 11 delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1,
- 12 2010. The governing board of a system may include coverage under
- 13 Section 1601.1021, Insurance Code, as added by this Act, in an
- 14 insurance policy or contract or an evidence of coverage delivered,
- 15 issued for delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2010, if the
- 16 governing board determines that the coverage may reasonably be
- 17 included.
- 18 SECTION 6. Except as otherwise provided by this Act, this
- 19 Act takes effect November 1, 2009.
