11	include eligible public junior college employees.
12	(b) For purposes of this section, a public junior college
13	employee is eligible if the employee is:
14	(1) otherwise eligible to participate in the group
15	benefits program; and
16	(2) an instructional or administrative employee whose
17	salary may be fully paid from funds appropriated under the General
18	Appropriations Act, regardless of whether the salary is actually
19	paid from appropriated funds.
20	(c) In determining the amount described in Subsection (a),
21	the number of eligible employees included for each college in each
22	biennium shall be adjusted in proportion to the change in student
23	enrollment at each college during the reporting period, except that
24	a college that experiences a decline in student enrollment may

1 petition to maintain the number of eligible employees at the same 2 level as the prior biennium.

3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 7 Act takes effect November 1, 2009.
