Amend CSHB 1363 (House Committee Report) by striking lines 13-21 on page 1 and substituting the following: person who:

(1) has a laboratory test to determine that level performed at a clinical laboratory in the district; and

(2) consents in writing to the inclusion of the person's information in the registry.

(d) <u>A physician practicing in the participating public</u> <u>health district who orders a glycosylated hemoglobin test for a</u> <u>patient shall submit to the clinical laboratory the diagnosis codes</u> <u>of a patient along with the patient's sample if the patient consents</u> <u>in writing to have the patient's information included in the</u> <u>registry.</u> A clinical laboratory located in the participating public health district shall submit to the district and the department <u>for a patient who has given written consent</u> the results of <u>the patient's [each]</u> glycosylated hemoglobin test <u>along with the</u> <u>diagnostic codes provided by the physician for that patient [that</u> <u>the laboratory performs]</u>.
