Amend CSHB 2730 (House committee printing) in ARTICLE 5 of the bill by adding the following appropriately numbered SECTION to that ARTICLE and renumbering the remaining SECTIONS of that ARTICLE accordingly:

SECTION 5.____. Section 411.005, Government Code, is amended by amending Subsections (a) and (c) and adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

- (a) The commission shall appoint a citizen of the United States [this state] as public safety director. The director serves until removed by the commission.
- (c) The commission shall select the director, and the director shall select an assistant director, on the basis of the person's training, experience, and qualifications for the position. The director and <u>each</u> [an] assistant director must, during the six-year period before appointment to the department as the director or as an assistant director, have been serving for a period of not less than five consecutive years as:
- (1) a full-time peace officer commissioned by a state, federal, local, or tribal law enforcement agency; and
- (2) the head of or a senior manager in a state, federal, local, or tribal law enforcement agency [five years' experience, preferably in police or public administration].
- $\underline{\text{(d)}}$ The director and an assistant director are entitled to annual salaries as provided by the legislature.
