### **BILL ANALYSIS**

S.B. 461 By: Gallegos Urban Affairs Committee Report (Unamended)

#### **BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE**

Current law authorizes a person over the age of 36 to take the firefighter entrance examination, even though a person that age is not eligible to be hired.

S.B. 461 prohibits a person 36 years of age or older from taking the firefighter entrance examination.

# **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

It is the committee's opinion that this bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, department, agency, or institution.

## **ANALYSIS**

S.B. 461 amends the Local Government Code to add provisions that apply primarily to a municipality that has a population of 10,000 or more, has a paid fire department or police department, and has voted to adopt the municipal civil service law for firefighters and police officers. The bill makes the law prohibiting a person from taking an entrance examination for a beginning position in the fire or police department unless the person is at least 18 years of age apply only to a beginning position in the police department. The bill prohibits a person from taking an entrance examination for a beginning position in the fire department unless the person is at least 18 years of age, but not 36 years of age or older.

## **EFFECTIVE DATE**

On passage, or, if the act does not receive the necessary vote, the act takes effect September 1, 2009.
