### **AUTHOR'S / SPONSOR'S STATEMENT OF INTENT**

The Tablerock Groundwater Conservation District, created by S.B. 3, 80th Legislature, Regular Session, 2007, is a single-county district in Coryell County. Coryell County is pursuing efforts to join an existing groundwater conservation district to manage the aquifer on a regional basis.

S.B. 663 relates to the dissolution of the Tablerock Groundwater Conservation District.

### **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

### **SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS**

SECTION 1. Provides that the Tablerock Groundwater Conservation District is finally dissolved on the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 2. Repealer: Chapter 8823 (Tablerock Groundwater Conservation District), Special District Local Laws Code.

SECTION 3. Effective date: upon passage or September 1, 2009.
