17	is amended by adding Section 372.002 to read as follows:
18	Sec. 372.002. METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION APPROVAL
19	OF TOLL PROJECTS. A member of the policy board of a metropolitan
20	planning organization may not participate in a vote of the board to
21	approve the construction of a new toll project or the conversion of
22	a nontolled project to a toll project unless the member is an

24	SECTION 3. (a) Section 1 of this Act takes effect only if
