(b) Except as otherwise provided by this section, a property 10 owners' association may not include or enforce a provision in a 11 12 dedicatory instrument that prohibits or restricts a property owner from installing a solar energy device. 13 14 (c) A provision that violates Subsection (b) is void. (d) This section does not prohibit the inclusion or 15 enforcement of a provision in a dedicatory instrument that 16 prohibits a solar energy device that: 17 18 (1) as adjudicated by a court: (A) threat<u>ens the public health or safety; or</u> 19 20 (B) violates a law; 21 (2) is located on property owned or maintained by the property owners' association; 22 23 (3) is located on property owned in common by the 24 members of the property owners' association; or

1	(4) is located in an area on the property owner's
2	property other than:
3	(A) on the roof of the home; or
4	(B) in a fenced yard or patio maintained by the
5	property owner.
6	SECTION 2. Section 202.008, Property Code, as added by this
7	Act, applies to a dedicatory instrument without regard to whether
8	the dedicatory instrument takes effect or is renewed before, on, or
9	after the effective date of this Act.
10	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
11	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

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
