5	SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 130, Local Government
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 130.910 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 130.910. NONBINDING REFERENDUM ON COUNTY FISCAL
8	MATTER. (a) The commissioners court of a county may hold a
9	nonbinding referendum in the county on any question affecting a
10	county fiscal matter other than a matter involving:
11	(1) a labor agreement; or
12	(2) compensation of any county employee.
13	(b) The referendum shall be held in the same manner as an
14	election on a county measure and must take place on an election date
15	authorized by Section 41.001, Election Code.
