11	(1) filed a workers' compensation claim in good faith;
12	(2) hired a lawyer to represent the employee in a
13	workers' compensation claim;
14	(3) instituted or caused to be instituted in good
15	faith a proceeding under Subtitle A; or
16	(4) testified or is about to testify in a proceeding
17	described by Subdivision (3) [under Subtitle A].
18	(b) A person may not discharge or in any other manner
19	discriminate against an employee whose employer does not have
20	workers' compensation insurance coverage because the employee has:
21	(1) instituted or caused to be instituted in good
22	faith a proceeding under common law relating to an injury sustained
23	by the employee in the course and scope of the employee's
24	employment, including an action described by Section 406.033; or

The change in law made by this Act applies only 3 4 to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of this Act. A cause of action that accrues before that date is 5 governed by the law as it existed immediately before the effective 6 date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that 7 8 purpose.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
