## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the use of revenue from a tax increment fund to acquire,

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 311.008(b), Tax Code, is amended to read
- 6 as follows:
- 7 (b) A municipality or county may exercise any power
- 8 necessary and convenient to carry out this chapter, including the
- 9 power to:
- 10 (1) cause project plans to be prepared, approve and
- 11 implement the plans, and otherwise achieve the purposes of the
- 12 plan;
- 13 (2) acquire real property by purchase, condemnation,
- or other means to implement project plans and sell that property on
- the terms and conditions and in the manner it considers advisable;
- 16 (3) enter into agreements, including agreements with
- 17 bondholders, determined by the governing body of the municipality
- or county to be necessary or convenient to implement project plans
- 19 and achieve their purposes, which agreements may include
- 20 conditions, restrictions, or covenants that run with the land or
- 21 that by other means regulate or restrict the use of land; and
- 22 (4) consistent with the project plan for the zone:

- 6 (B) acquire, construct, reconstruct, or install
- 7 public works, facilities, or sites or other public improvements,
- 8 including utilities, streets, street lights, water and sewer
- 9 facilities, pedestrian malls and walkways, parks, flood and

- 11 facilities[ , but not including educational facilities; or
- 12 [(C) in a reinvestment zone created on or before

- SECTION 2. Section 311.0085, Tax Code, is amended to read as
- 16 follows:
- 17 Sec. 311.0085. DEDICATION OF REVENUE TO SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR
- 18 EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES [POWER OF CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES]. (a)
- 19 [This section applies only to a municipality that has:
- 20 [(1) territory in three counties; and
- 21 [(2) a population of less than 120,000.
- [ $\frac{\text{(b)}}{\text{)}}$ ] In this section, "educational facility" has the
- 23 meaning assigned by Section 311.008.
- (b) [<del>(c)</del>] In addition to exercising the powers described by
- 25 Section 311.008, a municipality may enter into a new agreement, or
- 26 amend an existing agreement, with a school district that is located
- 27 in whole or in part in a reinvestment zone created by the

- 1 municipality to dedicate revenue from the tax increment fund to the
- 2 school district for acquiring, constructing, or reconstructing an
- 3 educational facility located in or outside of the zone.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
