## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the authority of certain private institutions of higher 3 education to enter into mutual assistance agreements regarding the enforcement of state or local law. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Sections 51.2125(a) and (c), Education Code, are amended to read as follows: 7 This section applies only to a private institution of 8 (a) higher education that [has a fall head count enrollment of more than 9 10,000 students and that] has under its control and jurisdiction 10 property that is contiguous to, or located in any part within the 11 12 boundaries of, a municipality that has [with] a population of more 13 than one million. For purposes of this section, a private 14 institution of higher education is a private or independent institution of higher education as defined by Section 61.003. 15 (c) A mutual assistance agreement authorized by this 16 section may designate the geographic area in which the campus peace 17 18 officers are authorized to provide assistance to the peace officers of the municipality, except that if the agreement is entered into 19 with a municipality that has [with] a population of more than one 20 21 million and that elects all or part of the municipality's governing 22 body from election districts, the designated geographic area consists of each of the election districts of the municipality's 23 governing body that contains any part of the campus of the 24

1 institution and each of the election districts of the governing 2 body that is contiguous to another municipality that contains any 3 part of the campus of the institution.

4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
