- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 25.081(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) Except as authorized under Subsection (b) of this
- 8 section, Section 25.084, [ex] Section 29.0821, or Section
- 9 29.908(e), for each school year each school district must operate
- 10 so that the district provides for at least 180 days of instruction
- 11 for students.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 25.0811(a), Education Code, is amended
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 (a) A school district may not begin instruction for students
- 15 for a school year before the fourth Monday in August unless:
- 16 (1) the district operates a year-round system under
- 17 Section 25.084; or
- 18 (2) the district is authorized to modify the
- instructional calendar as provided by Section 29.908(e).
- SECTION 3. Section 29.908, Education Code, is amended by
- 21 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- (e) A school district may allow a district high school that
- 23 provides an early college education program under this section to
- 24 modify the instructional calendar of the high school as necessary

- 1 to conform with the calendar of a college, university, or technical
- 2 school with which the high school has entered into an articulation
- 3 agreement as provided by Subsections (b)(3) and (b-1). The
- 4 commissioner shall adopt rules to administer this subsection.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
