SECTION 2. Section 1054.0565(a), Special District Local 15 Laws Code, as effective September 1, 2009, is amended to read as 16 follows: 17 It is a ground for removal from the board that a 18 (a) director: 19 (1) is absent from more than half [three-fourths] of 20 21 the regularly scheduled board meetings that the director is eligible to attend during a calendar year without an excuse 22 23 approved by a majority vote of the board; or 24 (2) fails to timely pay a federal, state, or local tax,

1 including an ad valorem tax.

2 SECTION 3. (a) Section 1 of this Act takes effect only if 3 the Act of the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, relating to 4 nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in existing codes does 5 not become law. If the Act of the 81st Legislature, Regular 6 Session, 2009, relating to nonsubstantive additions to and 7 corrections in existing codes becomes law, Section 1 of this Act has 8 no effect.

(b) Section 2 of this Act takes effect only if the Act of the 9 Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, 10 81st relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in existing codes 11 becomes law. If the Act of the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 12 2009, relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in 13 existing codes does not become law, Section 2 of this Act has no 14 15 effect.
