A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to evidence of motor vehicle financial responsibility;
- 3 providing a penalty.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 601.053, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows:
- 7 (c) A person commits an offense if the person fails or
- 8 refuses to provide to a peace officer the evidence of financial
- 9 responsibility as required by Subsection (a). An offense under
- 10 this subsection is a Class C misdemeanor.
- 11 (d) A court shall dismiss a charge of an offense under
- 12 Subsection (c) if the defendant presents to the court one of the
- 13 <u>documents listed in Subsection (a) that was valid at the time the</u>
- 14 offense occurred. The court may assess the defendant an
- 15 administrative fee not to exceed \$10 when the charge is dismissed.
- 16 Section 51.607, Government Code, does not apply to the
- 17 administrative fee.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
