7	Sec. 51.706. ADDITIONAL FILING FEE FOR CIVIL CASES IN BEXAR
8	COUNTY. (a) This section applies only to district courts,
9	statutory probate courts, and county courts at law in Bexar County.
10	(b) Except as otherwise provided by this section and in
11	addition to all other fees authorized or required by other law, the
12	clerk of a court shall collect a filing fee of not more than \$15 in
13	each civil case filed in the court to be used for the construction,
14	renovation, or improvement of the facilities that house the Bexar
15	County civil and criminal courts. The fee does not apply to a suit
16	affecting the parent-child relationship for the adoption of a child
17	or the termination of parental rights.
18	(c) Court fees due under this section shall be collected in
19	the same manner as other fees, fines, or costs are collected in the
20	case.
21	(d) The clerk at least monthly shall send the fees collected
22	under this section to the county treasurer or to any other official
23	who discharges the duties commonly assigned to the county
24	treasurer. The treasurer or other official shall deposit the fees

No. 144 1 in a special account in the county treasury dedicated to the 2 construction, renovation, or improvement of the facilities that 3 house the Bexar County civil and criminal courts. 4 This section applies only to the collection of fees for (e) 5 a 12-month period beginning October 1, if the commissioners court: 6 (1) adopts a resolution authorizing a fee of not more 7 than \$15; 8 (2) adopts a resolution requiring the county to spend one dollar for the construction, renovation, or improvement of the 9 10 court facilities for each dollar spent from the special account dedicated to that purpose; and 11 12 (3) files the resolutions with the county treasurer or with any other official who discharges the duties commonly assigned 13 to the county treasurer not later than September 1 immediately 14 preceding the first 12-month period during which the fees are to be 15 16 collected. 17 (f) A resolution adopted under Subsection (e) continues from year to year until October 1, 2024, allowing the county to 18 19 collect fees in accordance with this section until the resolution 20 is rescinded. 21 (g) The commissioners court may rescind a resolution 22 adopted under Subsection (e) by adopting a resolution rescinding the resolution and submitting the rescission resolution to the 23 24 county treasurer or to any other official who discharges the duties commonly assigned to the county treasurer not later than September 25 26 1 preceding the beginning of the first day of the county fiscal 27 year. The commissioners court may adopt another resolution in the

16	Government Code, in certain civil cases to fund the improvement of
17	court facilities, if authorized by the county commissioners court.
18	SECTION 3. Subchapter E, Chapter 101, Government Code, is
19	amended by adding Section 101.08111 to read as follows:
20	Sec. 101.08111. ADDITIONAL STATUTORY COUNTY COURT FEES:
21	GOVERNMENT CODE. The clerk of a statutory county court in Bexar
22	County shall collect an additional filing fee not to exceed \$15
23	under Section 51.706, Government Code, in certain civil cases to
24	fund the improvement of court facilities, if authorized by the
25	county commissioners court.
26	SECTION 4. Subchapter F, Chapter 101, Government Code, is
27	amended by adding Section 101.10111 to read as follows:

<u>GOVERNMENT CODE. The clerk of a statutory probate court in Bexar</u>
<u>County shall collect an additional filing fee not to exceed \$15</u>
<u>under Section 51.706, Government Code, in certain civil cases to</u>
<u>fund the improvement of court facilities, if authorized by the</u>
<u>county commissioners court.</u>

7 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
