## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the transfer of service credits to or from the elected

class in the Employees Retirement System of Texas.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 813.503(a), Government Code, is amended

6 to read as follows:

- 7 (a) A member may establish in, or have transferred to, the
- 8 employee class all service credited in the elected class, if the
- 9 contributions made to establish the service in the elected class
- 10 equal or exceed contributions required of a member of the employee
- 11 class for the same amount of service during the same time and at the
- 12 same rate of compensation. The member before retirement may
- 13 transfer the service credit back to the elected class. [A member or
- 14 retiree who has, or had at the time of retirement, at least eight
- 15 years of service credit in the elected class of membership,
- 16 exclusive of military service, may transfer service credit between
- 17 classes before or after retirement.
- 18 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 19 813.503(a), Government Code, applies only to service credit for
- 20 which a notification of transfer is made to the Employees
- 21 Retirement System of Texas on or after the effective date of this
- 22 Act. Service credit for which a notification of transfer is made
- 23 under Section 813.503(a), Government Code, before that date is
- 24 subject to the law in effect at the time the notification is made,

- 1 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect August 1, 2009, if it
- 3 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 4 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 5 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for effect on that
- date, this Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
