4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 2108.103, Government Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	Sec. 2108.103. RETENTION OF FUNDS. (a) The affected
8	agency retains [ <del>one-fourth of</del> ] the <u>full</u> amount of savings verified
9	by the comptroller [, not to exceed one percent of the amount of
10	undedicated general revenue derived from nonfederal sources
11	appropriated to the agency for the fiscal year in which the savings
12	are realized].
13	(b) Savings retained under this section may only be
14	appropriated by the legislature to the affected agency.
15	(c) The administrative head of the agency shall determine
16	how to spend the savings. The agency may spend the savings only on
17	an activity or expense that [ <del>does not</del> ]:
18	(1) <u>does not</u> create new or expanded services; [ <del>or</del> ]
19	(2) <u>does not</u> require ongoing funding at a later date <u>;</u>
20	and
21	(3) the administrative head of the agency determines
22	will enhance the agency's ability to perform the agency's duties.
23	(d) The agency may spend the savings on one-time merit
24	payments to employees in accordance with Section 659.255.
