- 7 (b) For purposes of Subsection (a)(1), "obtaining [obtaining] or furnishing information" [information] includes 8 information obtained or furnished through the review and analysis 9 of, and the investigation into the content of, computer-based data 10 11 not available to the public. For purposes of Subsection (a)(1), 12 "obtaining or furnishing information" does not include information obtained or furnished by an information technology professional 13

- 18 (2) is not performing any other act that requires a

- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
