## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 35, Utilities Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 35.009 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 35.009. BILLING DEMAND FOR CERTAIN UTILITY CUSTOMERS.
- 9 Notwithstanding any other provision of this code, a transmission
- 10 and distribution utility shall exclude the following from the
- 11 application of any ratchet provision contained in a tariff relating
- 12 to distribution service:
- 13 (1) public and private schools;
- 14 (2) nonprofit athletic and sports associations; and
- 15 (3) municipally owned facilities.
