## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to a study of the proportion of this state's electric

- 3 energy that can be generated using renewable energy technology.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The state energy conservation office shall
- 6 conduct a study to determine how not less than 25 percent of this
- 7 state's electric energy may be generated by renewable energy
- 8 technologies by January 1, 2025.
- 9 SECTION 2. The state energy conservation office, in
- 10 conducting the study, shall examine costs and efficiencies of
- 11 available renewable energy technologies for electric energy
- 12 generation and shall recommend legislative and administrative
- 13 policy changes necessary to achieve the goal of having not less than
- 14 25 percent of this state's electric energy generated by renewable
- energy technologies by January 1, 2025.
- 16 SECTION 3. The state energy conservation office shall
- 17 consult with the Public Utility Commission of Texas in conducting
- 18 the study. The commission shall cooperate with the office in
- 19 conducting the study.
- 20 SECTION 4. The state energy conservation office shall
- 21 present the office's report to the governor, the lieutenant
- governor, and the speaker of the house of representatives not later
- 23 than January 1, 2011.
- 24 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
