- 5 SECTION 1. Section 11.056(b), Education Code, is amended to

However, if a 3 4 candidate whose name is to appear on the ballot dies or is declared ineligible after the 65th [48th] day before election day, a 5 6 declaration of write-in candidacy for the office sought by the deceased or ineligible candidate may be filed not later than 5 p.m. 7 8 of the 59th [42nd] day before election day.

- 20 (3) Section 63.0945(f), Water Code.
- 21 SECTION 9. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 22 an election ordered on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 23 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
