1-9 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-10 AN ACT

1-11 relating to the designation of enterprise projects during a
1-12 biennium.

1-13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-14 SECTION 1. Section 2303.406(d), Government Code, is amended
1-15 to read as follows:

1-16 (d) The maximum number of enterprise projects that the bank
1-17 may designate for each nominating body during any biennium is:

1-18 (1) six, if the nominating body is the governing body
1-19 of ~~[four, plus two additional bonus projects the bank may award in]~~
1-20 a municipality or county with a population of less than 250,000; or

1-21 (2) nine ~~[six]~~, if the nominating body is the
1-22 governing body of a municipality or county with a population of
1-23 250,000 or more.

1-24 SECTION 2. Section 2303.406(e), Government Code, is amended
1-25 as follows:

1-26 (e) The office may, during any biennium, designate multiple
1-27 concurrent enterprise projects to a qualified business located at a
1-28 qualified business site ~~[in an enterprise zone]~~.

1-29 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
