A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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| 2 | relating to the requirement that state agencies report the cost of |
| 3 | services and benefits provided to unlawful immigrants. |
| 4 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: |

- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2101.0115, Government Code, is amended 6 by amending Subsections (c) and (d) and adding Subsection (e) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (c) A state agency's annual report must include:
- 9 (1) the name and job title of each bonded agency 10 employee, the amount of the bond, and the name of the surety company 11 that issued the bond;
- 12 (2) an analysis of space occupied by the agency,
 13 including:
- 14 (A) the total amount of space rented by the 15 agency, expressed in square feet;
- 16 (B) the total amount of space occupied by the 17 agency in state-owned buildings, expressed in square feet;
- (C) the name and address of each building in which the agency occupies space and the amount of square feet in each building devoted to each particular use;
- 21 (D) the cost per square foot of all rented space;
- (E) the annual and monthly cost of all rented
- 23 space;
- 24 (F) the name of each lessor of space rented by the

- 1 agency;
- 2 (G) a description of the agency's progress toward
- 3 achieving the objective provided by Section 2165.104, if the agency
- 4 is subject to that section; and
- 5 (H) any other information helpful to describe the
- 6 agency's use of space;
- 7 (3) an itemization of all fees paid by the agency for
- 8 professional or consulting services provided under Subchapter A or
- 9 B, Chapter 2254, including the name of each person receiving those
- 10 fees and the reason for the provision of the services;
- 11 (4) an itemization of all fees paid by the agency for
- 12 legal services, other than legal services provided by an agency
- 13 employee or the attorney general, including the name of each person
- 14 receiving those fees and the reason for the provision of the
- 15 services;
- 16 (5) a copy of the form prepared by the agency under
- 17 Section 2205.041, relating to the agency's use and cost of
- 18 operating aircraft that are state-owned or under rental or
- 19 long-term lease;
- 20 (6) an itemization of any purchases made under Section
- 21 2155.067, including each product purchased, the amount of the
- 22 purchase, and the name of the vendor;
- 23 (7) for each fiscal year ending in an even-numbered
- 24 calendar year:
- 25 (A) a copy of the master file report verification
- 26 form certified by the General Land Office, if applicable to the
- 27 agency, to confirm that the agency is in compliance with Subchapter

- 1 E, Chapter 31, Natural Resources Code; or
- 2 (B) if the agency's inventory record is
- 3 inaccurate or incomplete, a statement that the agency will submit
- 4 the appropriate forms to the General Land Office not later than the
- 5 15th day after the date the agency submits its annual report;
- 6 (8) a copy of the report prepared by the agency under
- 7 Section 2161.124, relating to the agency's use of historically
- 8 underutilized businesses;
- 9 (9) a report of each transfer of appropriated money
- 10 between appropriation items that shows the sum of all transfers
- 11 affecting each item;
- 12 (10) an itemization of each passenger vehicle the
- 13 agency purchased, including the make, model, purchase price,
- 14 assigned type of use, and fuel efficiency as expressed by the
- 15 manufacturer's fuel efficiency rating;
- 16 (11) a schedule, applicable to state agencies
- 17 determined by the Legislative Budget Board, detailing total
- 18 expenditures by or on behalf of the agency for:
- 19 (A) employee benefits, including social
- 20 security, health insurance, retirement contributions, benefit
- 21 replacement pay, and workers' and unemployment compensation
- 22 payments;
- 23 (B) bond debt service; and
- 24 (C) payments for general governmental services
- 25 as defined by the comptroller, including services of the
- 26 comptroller, the attorney general, the General Services
- 27 Commission, the Department of Information Resources, and the state

- 1 auditor;
- 2 (12) for an institution of higher education, the total
- 3 amount of lump-sum vacation and compensatory leave payments made to
- 4 employees who separated from state service during the fiscal year;
- 5 (13) the name and job title of each state officer or
- 6 employee authorized to use a state-owned or state-leased vehicle
- 7 and the reasons for the authorization, in accordance with Section
- 8 2113.013; [and]
- 9 (14) a report of expenditures made for each commodity
- 10 or service identified under Section 2155.448, including:
- 11 (A) the total amount spent on those commodities
- 12 and services;
- 13 (B) the total amount spent for commodities and
- 14 services purchased that accomplish the same purpose; and
- 15 (C) the total amount spent for all other
- 16 recycled, remanufactured, or environmentally sensitive commodities
- or services, itemized by type of commodity or service; and
- 18 (15) a report of the cost of services and benefits
- 19 provided to unlawfully present immigrants, with the agency
- 20 determining the extent to which unlawfully present immigrants are
- 21 served by the agency by:
- 22 (A) asking each recipient of a service or benefit
- 23 whether the individual is an unlawfully present immigrant, unless
- 24 prohibited by other law;
- 25 (B) considering statements and other information
- 26 provided by the recipient of a service or benefit that identifies
- 27 the recipient as an unlawfully present immigrant, including place

- of birth, registration with the Social Security Administration to
- 2 the extent that information may be lawfully obtained, and work
- 3 history; or
- 4 (C) using a statistical method developed by the
- 5 agency if it is not practical for the agency to directly determine
- 6 whether each recipient of a service or benefit is an unlawfully
- 7 present immigrant.
- 8 (d) In this section:
- 9 (1) "Annual report" means the annual report required
- 10 by this section.
- 11 (2) "Appropriated money" means money appropriated by
- 12 the legislature under the General Appropriations Act or other law.
- 13 (3) "Appropriation item" includes an item listed in
- 14 the General Appropriations Act under an informational listing of
- 15 appropriated funds.
- 16 <u>(4) "Unlawfully present immigrant" means an</u>
- 17 <u>individual who is not:</u>
- 18 (A) a United States citizen;
- 19 (B) a legal permanent resident of the United
- 20 States; or
- 21 <u>(C)</u> a qualified alien or nonimmigrant under the
- 22 Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. Section 1101 et seq.) who
- 23 is legally present in the United States.
- (e) A state agency shall also submit the report required
- 25 under Subsection (c)(15) to the lieutenant governor, speaker of the
- 26 house of representatives, and members of the legislature.
- 27 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act to Section

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- 1 2101.0115, Government Code, apply only in relation to an
- 2 application for a service or benefit that is made on or after the
- 3 effective date of this Act.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
