1 occupational license after a conviction under the laws of this

3 [(c)] A petition filed under this section must set forth in 4 detail the person's essential need.

5 (c) [(d) A petition filed under Subsection (b) must state
6 that the petitioner was convicted in that court for an offense under
7 the laws of this state.

8 [(e)] The clerk of the court shall file the petition as in 9 any other [civil] matter.

10 (d) [(f)] A court may not grant an occupational license for 11 the operation of a commercial motor vehicle to which Chapter 522 12 applies.

13 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 14 to a petition requesting an occupational driver's license that is 15 filed on or after the effective date of this Act. A petition for an 16 occupational driver's license that is filed before the effective 17 date of this Act is covered by the law in effect on the date the 18 petition was filed, and the former law is continued in effect for 19 that purpose.
