 10 on the public's health and physical property of expected air
 11 contaminant emissions from the facility or proposed facility and
 12 from other facilities located less than three miles from the

- SECTION 2. Section 382.055(d), Health and Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- (d) In determining whether and under which conditions a preconstruction permit should be renewed, the commission shall consider, at a minimum:

- SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to the issuance or renewal of a permit the application for which is
- 6 filed with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality on or
- 7 after the effective date of this Act. The issuance or renewal of a
- 8 permit the application for which is filed with the Texas Commission
- 9 on Environmental Quality before the effective date of this Act is
- 10 governed by the law in effect when the application is filed, and the
- 11 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
